

Confidentiality and the UKACR Cancer Information Service

In applying for access to the CIS users must agree to abide by the guidelines from the UK Association of Cancer Registries and the Department of Health (see www.ukacr.org.uk), which consider rates or counts based on populations smaller than 1,000 or cells with fewer than 5 counts to be potentially disclosive.

It is the responsibility of the authorised user to ensure that potentially disclosive analyses based upon data held within the CIS are not made available outside the CIS. This includes combinations of analyses that have potential for disclosure by differencing.

If a user plans to make any data or analyses extracted from the CIS available in a public report, a draft copy must be sent to the appropriate cancer registry for approval, prior to publication.


